CELEBRATE SUCCESS 2024





Over the past five years the FOCUS Foundation has been promoting gardening through my own personal garden. In 2019 we held yoga classes and taught gardening to several of the participants in the central PA area. While teaching how to thin perennials it occurred to me that we had lots of extra plants that I was just going to discard as we had so many. It was decided to take those extra plants and offer them on Facebook marketplace for a small fee, benefiting the FOCUS Foundation. The first year we raised several hundred dollars.

In the spring of 2020, as all of us remember, COVID-19 became a way of life. Many people were stuck at home, isolated and with little to pass the time. Although our gardening classes could not be held, I was still working alone in my garden and continued to offer plants for sale on Facebook Marketplace. In 2020 we raised over \$3,000. It was amazing! Although we may be limited due to state regulations, we are still able to offer plants to our community, and raise money for the FOCUS Foundation.

Keep an eye out this spring, summer and fall on Facebook Marketplace, for our plant sales. They will be offered by me personally (Cindy Domeier), but all the proceeds from the plant sales goes to the FOCUS Foundation. We will have plants for sale at our annual Celebrate Success Event. Tom's Story

A few months ago, my individual, Tom, had expressed interest in hosting an Adult Autism Support Group. He had hosted this group in the past, but due to the COVID-19 pandemic, his group had unfortunately been disbanded. Tom had expressed to his team that he saw his group as an asset, to adults like himself, in providing the opportunity of giving social and emotional support to those within his community. He had expressed how vital it was for others to socialize and have fun with one another through these community activities, which he had noticed a lack of in the area that he resides. The group was very important to Tom back in the day, and he told us (his team) how it had brought a sense of fulfillment to his life and to the lives of those who had attended in the past, based on the peer review he had received.

After a lot of hard work, planning and coordination with staff, family, and himself, Tom was finally able to bring his beloved group back to life in December of 2023. In the past, he had seen attendance numbers of around thirty people, and although the December meeting only saw an attendance of three individuals, Tom did not let this discourage him and he is continuing on with hosting. To his surprise, the latest meeting in January saw almost double the amount of individuals AND staff, which served to boost Tom's confidence in the group and his ability to host. Despite the occasional setback here and there, Tom has said how much he looks forward to hosting in the future and how he hopes for the group to grow into what it used to be back in its heyday. He enjoys planning games and activities for everyone, as well as deciding what kind of refreshments he's going to provide next, switching things up month to month. Tom hopes that by featuring this story, he'll see an even greater increase in attendance in the near future. His group is open to anyone within the adult autism community.


